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The vendor registration fee is \$100 for the year. For vendors who only set up on Tuesdays, fee is \$40 for year. Week by week basis is \$20 per week. The regular season runs from May 3th through October 25th. Full season membership allows vendors to set up year-round. If a full season member is unable to make a market day, they must inform the Market Master via email or phone call a minimum of 7 days prior to the market date. If a vendor is absent more than two regular season market days, without proper notice, they will lose their preferred vendor space for the remaining portion of the season and future booth location will be based upon availability.

1. Pavilion spaces are 10x10 each. Both the north and south pavilion have one parking spot for each booth space so a truck can easily back up to the pavilion and store goods for sale.
2. After the pavilion spaces are filled, we will add vendors in the courtyard area of the market, Tents are the vendors responsibility.
